Dr. Ass. Prof. Ebrahim Afsah has been educated at the School of Oriental and African Studies, London (1992–96); Trinity College Dublin (1997–98 and 2002–08); the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University (1999–2001); and the Max Planck Institute of Comparative Public Law and International Law (MPIL), Heidelberg. Since 2012 he has been associate professor at the University of Copenhagen. Prior to joining the faculty in Copenhagen, Dr. Afsah was a senior governance expert with Deloitte Consulting LLP in Arlington, Virginia. He has extensive overseas consulting experience starting in 2003 when he set up the ongoing legal training programmes of the Max Planck Institute in Afghanistan and Jordan, followed by a long line of professional engagements on constitutional and public law reform, monitoring and evaluation, legal training, and administrative reform for the World Bank, UNDP, UNODC, GTZ, the German Foreign Office, the US State Department, and the European Union.
